There are two airports we recommend for visiting Yosemite National Park. The first is San Francisco International Airport (SFO). It is located 200 miles west of Yosemite National Park. You can arrive at SFO and take public transportation all the way to Yosemite by using Amtrak<sup>1</sup> from the Bay Area or rent a vehicle.

The closest airport with links to ground transportation is Fresno/Yosemite International Airport. It is located about 2 hours drive from the southern entrance to Yosemite National Park. You can fly into Fresno and either rent a car or take the YARTS bus to Yosemite Valley.

The Mariposa Airport is also an option for private planes.

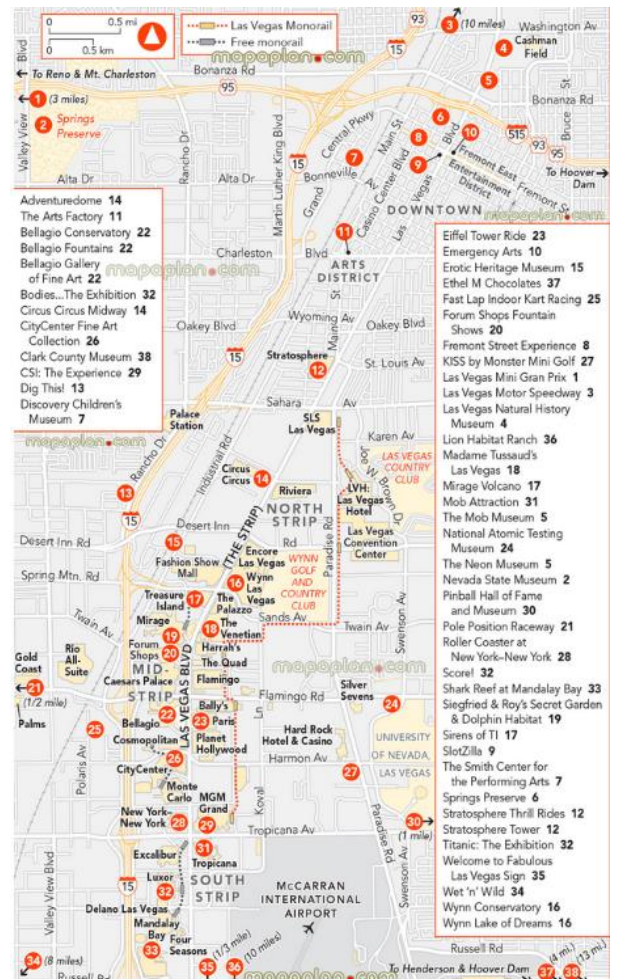

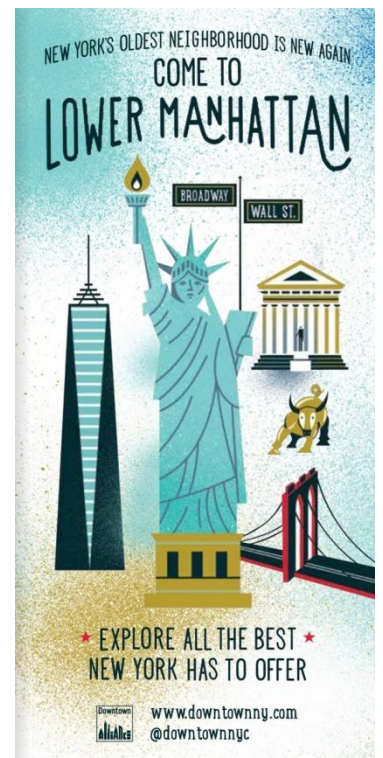
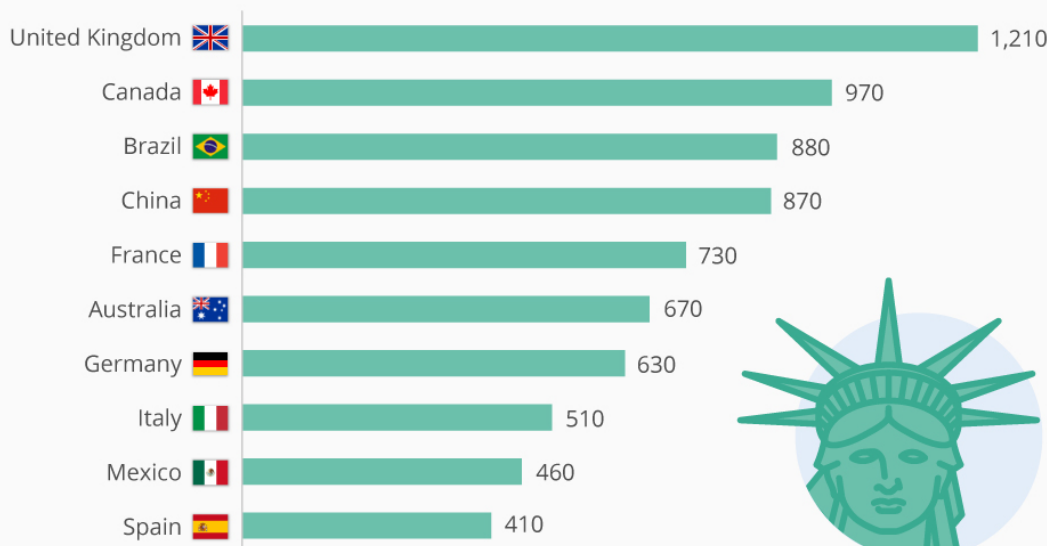

Number of visitors to New York City, by country of origin (in 1,000s)

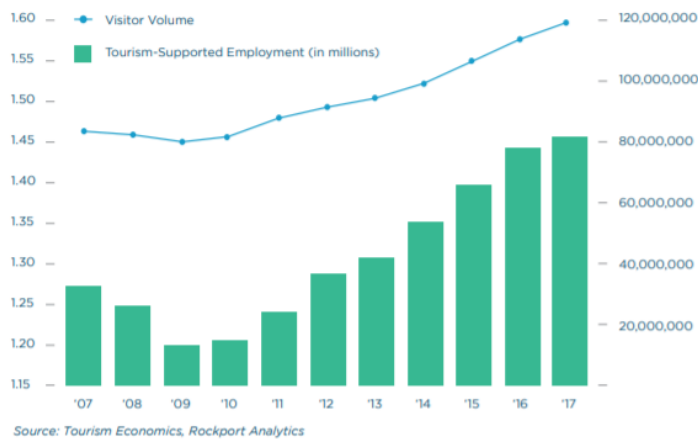
